

Manual Availability Reporting

Camping sites that report availability manually **MUST** not provide exact numerical values.

Instead, for each Camping Category, they must select one of the following predefined availability statuses:

- **Sufficient spots available** (0% - 70%)
- **Few spots available** (71% - 99%)
- **Fully booked** (100%)

Validity Period

For each availability status, the camping site **MUST** define its validity:

The camping site can specify a date range (start date → end date) during which the selected availability status applies

OR

The camping site can select “until further notice”

Behavior:

If a date range is defined:

The availability status is only valid within that period

If “until further notice” is selected:

The availability status remains active indefinitely

No update is required until the availability changes

Display Availability from campsites with API

For campsites connected via API, availability on campnow is calculated based on occupancy percentage. The system uses the provided data (capacity, occupied spots, or available spots) to determine occupancy and converts it into standardized user-facing statuses:

- **Sufficient spots available** (0–70% occupied)
- **Few spots available** (71–99% occupied)
- **Fully booked** (100% occupied)

Exact numerical values are stored internally but are not displayed to users, ensuring a consistent and comparable experience across all campsites.

If we do not get the total amount of places of each categories via API, the campsite needs to add the total amount of places for the category in the backend.
